



Program Instructor – Arts and Crafts

Minimum qualifications: At least 18 years of age, and one year’s experience instructing art activities with youth. Must enjoy working with children of all backgrounds, and be passionate about working outdoors and engaging campers ages 5 – 15.

- All staff must be CPR/First Aid certified

Preferred qualifications: Bachelor’s Degree in process and at least two years of direct experience instructing arts activities.

Camp Beech Cliff welcomes qualified applicants for the Arts Program Instructor position to assist in instructional and fun art programs. This instructor works alongside the Program Head of Arts and Crafts to plan creative and engaging art projects for campers, ages 5 to 15 at various levels. This position calls for a strong organizational sense and excellent communication skills. All staff must adhere to the health and safety laws set forth by the State of Maine Dept. of Human Services Youth Camps Division, and standards for accreditation with the American Camping Association.

Considerations: Applicants should realize that camp jobs are challenging, demanding, and require a great deal of patience and understanding. Personal lifestyle sacrifices may have to be made including disconnecting from daily use of digital technology during the camp day. At CBC, sensitive and dynamic leadership is necessary to provide youngsters the opportunity to grow, learn to positively relate to others, establish life-long values, and increase their appreciation of the natural world.
